& JORDAN'S MILL, RIVERSIDE CAFÉ & GARDEN, NR BIGGLESWADE

Kathy Brown's garden is 4.5 acres with many different areas to enjoy. This should be a glorious time with cherry blossoms, lilacs, alliums, perennial honesty, aquilegias, tulips and tree peonies in flower; the herbaceous borders, art gardens, containers, cottage garden and wild flower meadow will each be full of interest. Optional guided tour can be booked. General introduction on arrival, refreshments (tea or coffee and home-made cakes) at 11 am.

Jordan's Mill: Entrance to the historic mill (now a museum) a souvenir Guide Book and a self-guided tour are included in the basic cost of the trip, together with free entry to the gardens, allotment, Mill Meadow and Woodland. Explore the beautiful Mill Gardens with their crops of cereals, fruits and vegetables growing alongside ornamental flowers and plants, and enjoy the wildlife and tranquillity of the meadow and woodland. You can enjoy freshly prepared food and drink in the Riverside Café overlooking the stunning views of the River Ivel.

The coach leaves Hatch End at 9:00 am from outside Morrisons.

Cost: £37.50 for HEHS members, £39.50 non-members.

Guided tour of Kathy Brown's garden (£2), Jordan's Mill (£2) and garden (£5) are optional extras.
