Sow Wild! is a project run by researchers at the University Of Sussex, investigating the effects of wildflowers upon pollinator numbers in urban environments. We hope the results will tell us more about how best to look after pollinators in our gardens and allotments.

Volunteers will receive a project pack, including native wildflower seeds to be sown in the spring of 2016. We ask that:

- You live within the UK
- You have an allotment or garden of minimum 20 square metres with space to sow a 2x2m wildflower patch
- You can spare a couple of hours over the summer to sample insects in the wildflower patch
